COUNCIL REPORTS **Mayor Merchant** - Thanked City staff for their hard work in support of the Serve First Open ATP Challenger 125 Tournament held August 11-17, 2025. Mayor Pro Tempore Blassingame - Attended the Serve First Open Tournament on August 11-12, 2025. - Bartlette Street needs to be resurfaced due to several potholes. - Trash and other items are being dumped in the Cook Street area, including Queen Street and South Street. - Inquired about a grand opening date for Westend Park on Oakland Avenue. Staff estimated an opening date near the end of September 2025. Attended the Santee-Lynches Regional Council of Governments Board meeting on August 11, 2025, along with Mayor Merchant and Councilman Gibson. Councilman Hastie The City Manager provided City updates at the South Sumter Neighborhood Beautification Association meeting on August 18, 2025. - Additional benches are requested for installation under the airnasium and at the pickleball courts in South Sumter Park. - The South Sumter Farmers Market is held each Friday from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Fifty (50) boxes of food will be given away to seniors on Friday, August 22, 2025. Dr. Shaun Owens, Associate Professor at the University of South Carolina's College of Social Work, recently conducted several community seminars in Sumter on aging in place. Councilman Davis Provided a brief Sumter Area Transportation Study (SUATS) update. Some of the major projects included the following: - Red Bay Road Bridge - Manning Avenue Bridge Replacement - Broad Street/US-378 Improvements near Shaw Air Force Base, Saint Paul's Church Road, and Oleander Drive - Guignard Drive and Bultman Drive Corridor Improvements on North Main Street and Manning Avenue Attended a swim meet at the Aquatics Center on August 16, 2025. Councilwoman Kennedy - The Serve First Open Tournament was very successful.
