CHASSIS DEALERS: Please ensure chassis specs meet body manufacturer's minimum requirements, which are supplied upon request. Deviations may result in additional charges, for which the truck

dealer will be responsible.

CHASSIS DEALER PAYMENT TERMS: Payment term begins when truck is delivered to customer or truck dealer for PDI, whichever is first. Payments received later than 15 DAYS are subject to penalty of Prime % APR, calculated on a daily basis. ANY EXCEPTIONS must be agreed to writing prior to order.









SYSTEM DESCRIPTION:

The RS-3 is a loader mounted to a chassis with a short wheel base. From the upper cab, the operator can drive the RS-3 and load waste into a separate haul truck. Most loading operations do not require outriggers (see load chart).

Because of the unique nature of this unit, there are very specific chassis requirements. Please contact Petersen for a complete list.




CONTROL OPTIONS:
