

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1028

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENTRY OF A
PURCHASE CONTRACT IN EXCESS OF \$100,000
(STORM DRAIN REPAIR ON WACTOR STREET)**

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Sumter, South Carolina (the "City"), has enacted an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Procurement Procedures for the City of Sumter, South Carolina" (the "Purchasing Ordinance");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Purchasing Ordinance, the Council must approve by resolution any purchase contract subject to the Purchasing Ordinance that exceeds \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has been presented with a request to approve a purchase contract in excess of \$100,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

Section 1. The Council hereby approves a purchase contract (the "Contract") for the supplies, services, equipment, or construction identified below:

SUBJECT: Recommendation to Contract for Storm Drain Repair on Wactor Street

A quote was received from Gulf Coast Underground to rehabilitate and line 321 linear feet of storm sewer line with spin casting. Gulf Coast Underground is a contracted vendor for the Trenchless Pipeline Rehabilitation Services for our area through the Houston Galveston Area Council (HGACBuy) Contract #TP07-25. The Municipal Association of South Carolina has a partnership with HGACBuy allowing its members to access services and meet competitive bidding requirements.

Gulf Coast Underground office is in Theodore, Alabama and their quote for lining is \$137,573.00 and will be funded with Storm Water Reserve Funds.

It is suggested that we contract with Gulf Coast Underground for this project.

BOND AND SALES TAX IS EXCLUDED (ADD 2% IF BOND IS REQUIRED). QUANTITIES ARE ESTIMATES ONLY. PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE FOR THE ACTUAL WORK PERFORMED AT THE SPECIFIED UNIT PRICES. PRICING IS BASED ON GCU BEING CONTRACTED FOR ALL WORK QUOTED.

Proposal inclusions:

1. All labor, equipment, and materials required to install Liner to the Storm Pipe.
2. Normal cleaning and surface preparation.
3. One mobilization.
4. Certificate of insurance within normal limits.
5. Worker's compensation insurance and employer's liability insurance.

The following is to be provided to GCU at no charge:

1. Supply water, free of charge, for the equipment required to clean structures.
2. Ingress and egress access to manholes and the site work area(s) adequate for set up, operation, maintenance, and removal of equipment and related site restoration, if any. Equipment is not 4x4 off-road capable and shall be capable of accessing manholes under its own power. NOTE: If manholes and structures are not located, accessible, and uncovered prior to GCU arrival, time spent to prepare the manhole for access will be billed at the rate of \$850/Hr.
3. Structures to be rehabbed will be located and identified prior to GCU mobilization.
4. Bypass of existing sewerage flow, if required.
5. Plugging of lines 12" or greater in diameter.
6. Police detail, DOT permitting, and other Traffic Control (signage, flaggers, etc.), if required. GCU will **only** provide cones to go around our vehicles.

Other terms:

1. Payment due within **thirty (30)** days of our invoice.
2. Stated prices are in effect for thirty days from the date of this proposal.
3. A service charge of 1-1/2% per month, which is an annual rate of 18%, will be added for all past due accounts.
4. As the prevailing party in any dispute between the parties arising out of or related to this contract or the breach thereof, GCU shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorney's fees and expenses incurred in pursuing or defending the claim.

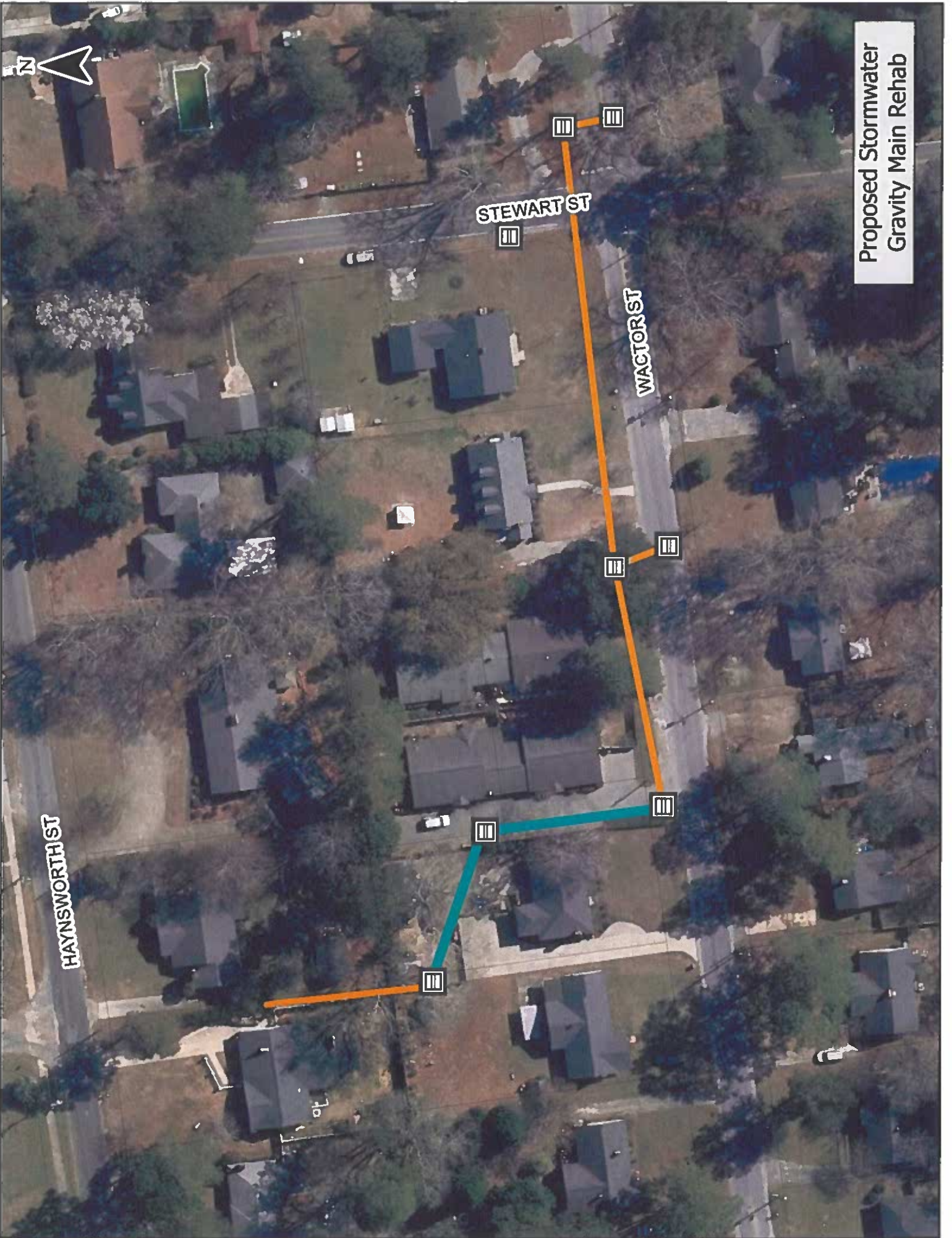
